REPORT OF TRAFFIC SUB-COMMITTEE

The Sub-Committee met on the 5th March when there were present Mr. C. T. Larkin, Mr. J. A. Percival, Mr. C. T. Phillips, Mr. N. Walker and Mr. M. J. Watts. Mr. Percival took the Chair.

The Sub-Committee considered the following matters referred to it by the Planning and Highways Committee. It also considered a suggestion from a local resident for the introduction of traffic calming measures in Brookhill Road, Copthorne. The Sub-Committee make the following recommendations -

Brookhill Road

That the possible introduction of calming measures be discussed with the County Council. Also that "Speedwatch" activity in the road be encouraged.

Church Road - One Way System

That the matter be raised again with the County Council with the suggestion that a possible experimental period be tried.

A.264/Newtown Junction

The possibility of the installation of traffic signals at the junction seems remote and the County Council has no plans to reconsider the matter in the foreseeable future. It will be suggested that more lighting will help the situation, however.

Sunny Avenue - Speed Humps

That no further action be taken to pursue the past suggestion that speed humps might be introduced in the road.

Burleigh Way - Traffic Calming Point

That no further action be taken to pursue the idea of a traffic calming feature in Burleigh Way, similar to that on Copthorne Bank.

Sandy Lane and Vicarage Road - Traffic Islands

That no further action be taken to pursue the original suggestion some years ago for the installation of traffic islands in Sandy Lane and Vicarage Road.

B.2028

That further talks be held with the County Council to pursue the suggestions for possible improvements at the various junctions with the B.2028 in Crawley Down .

Crawley Down - Shops Area

That discussions also take place with the County Council about the possible introduction of some form of speed restrictions in the area of the shops in Crawley Down, the suggestion having been made that the cessation of "echelon" parking in the area has led to an increase in traffic speeds which might be stopped by, for instance, the provision of speed humps in various places..
